



Every class herein is covered by the rules and specifications of their affiliated breed organization and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Entries

Entries close September 06, 2024. Entries received thereafter will be accepted at an additional fee of \$5.00 per horse. There will be an Office Fee of \$20.00 per horse.

All incomplete entries will be viewed as a post entry and will be charged the post entry fee.

Documentation Required

The following credentials must be available to competition management

- A. Negative Coggins dated no earlier than 12/01/2023, out of state horse must present current health papers.
- B. Copy of registration papers showing proof of ownership or paper demonstrating eligibility to show.

Stabling & Bedding

Stabling manager, Bill Tressler (517) 521-3515 <u>hevonen@fnwusers.com</u> In no way may stalls be painted or marred and the driving of nails, screws, staples, etc. is strictly forbidden. For your protection, you must inspect stalls assigned to you upon arrival and request verification from the barn manager of any damage. This procedure will prevent your being charged for the damage. No bedding will be furnished.

You may bring in your own shavings, or shavings will be available for purchase on the show grounds for \$9.00 a bag (payable to: S.C.A.S) and can be pre-ordered through the stabling manager before the show.

Practice

The warm up arena will be available for practice continually except for one hour before each performance, The warm up ring is under the same roof as the main arena and climate controlled. There is also an outdoor arena to the south you can use.

Ring Procedures

The gate to the show ring will remain open two minutes after the first horse enters the show ring; after which, the gate will be closed and any exhibitor not in the ring by that time will not be admitted. Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, paddock calls over the PA system must be considered a courtesy. Therefore, no protest will be upheld nor will any section be changed on the basis of a PA malfunction.




